Ves on 2C—Road Improvement Sales Tax

City of Colorado Springs voters will be asked to approve question 2C. This ballot question will extend the city's 0.57 percent sales tax dedicated to road maintenance. The tax currently is set to expire in 2025. Approval of 2C will extend the tax for 10 additional years. Colorado Springs voters first approved the 2C sales tax in 2015 and renewed it in 2019. The city has used the tax to repave 1,600 lane miles, install more than 9,400 new and retrofitted pedestrian ramps, and replace almost 306 miles of curb and gutter and 3.6 million square feet of sidewalk.
